Today you will start in Principe Real neighborhood and meander downhill to the riverfront. Take historic Tram 24 (E24) from stop Praça Luís de Camões (near G) to stop Rue Escola Politecnica (Near A). Most tourists don't make it up this far. Choose the stops that sound the best to you, sip a drink with a view, and live that Lisbon lifestyle. A. Jardim do Principe Real

Start at 10 AM

See: grab a bica (espresso) from a kiosk and relax under the fanning cypress tree



D. Gloria Funicular

The 1885 funicular had a deadly accident in late 2025 and is closed at this time.



G. A Brasileira Cafe

See: sit on Rua Garrett, the shopping road of Chiado, to enjoy this famous 1905 cafe.



B. Convento de São Pedro de Alcântara

See: A convent from 1670 with blue-and-white tiles depicting the life of St. Peter of Alcântara



E. Carmo Convent

See: ruins of a 14th century gothic church. Destroyed in the 1755 earthquake. Closed Sundays. 7€ entry.



H. Bica Funicular (Navegante Card)

See: snap one of the most iconic streets of Lisbon. Take the funicular or walk down.



C. Miradouro de São Pedro de Alcântara

See: the best view in Lisbon with fountains, live music, and kiosks



F. St. Justa Lift

See: enter the observation deck. Take the lift down but beware of the line back up! Use your Navegante Card



I. Time Out Market

See: 25 restaurants, 8 bars, & 25 shops with communal tables. Enjoy the atmosphere.
